The response of each individual over the age of 16 (not just each household) is crucially important because the results of this survey provide a "portrait" of Trinity that will be the basis both for your discernment of candidates and candidates' discernment of ministry here. All responses are anonymous.

<u>August 10th</u> Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search and Profile Committees to introduce the logistics of the search and to do a Mutual Ministry Review.

<u>September 12th</u> Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search, and Profile Committees to review the results of the CAT and to advise them on beginning work on the Profile.

Sacred Ground:

A Film-Based Dialogue Series on Race & Faith Sacred Ground is a film- and readings-based series on race, grounded in faith. Small groups will walk through chapters of America's history of race and racism, while weaving in threads of family story, economic class, and political and regional identity. This program designed by The Episcopal Church has 10 sessions; groups of 4-10 participants will meet every other week,

Community Dinners

We distributed 50 meals in less than an hour at Trinity on July 30th and we arranged for a delivery of meals to Cornerstone Assisted Living Center on July 23rd. We will distribute Grab-n-Go meals prepared by Oliva's on **August 27th** and meals will be delivered to Whitcomb House in August. Through your generousity we have been able to continue feeding about 100 people every month, in addition to supporting our local businesses. Please contact Glen Peterson or Mother Judith if you are able to help. We have applied for a grant from the Milford Community Health Network (CHNA) to continue this program through December.
