**Holy Communion:** We will have a service of Holy Communion on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Families may share Holy Communion at home with a pre-consecrated hosts. As an unusual accommodation during covid, we are allowed to store some of the Reserve Sacrament at home to be consumed during the livestreamed service of Holy Eucharist.

**Consecrated wafers at home:** Because the communion wafers have been consecrated, they should be set aside in a protected place. Some people create a small shrine on a table, set with a clean cloth and a candle. The usual practice for worship is to set a table with a white cloth, the wafers on a nice plate, and a candle. Before the service, it is recommended that you open the bag and put the wafer on the plate, and washing your hands before touching the wafer itself.

You may pick up consecrated wafers in biodegradable plastic bags to keep at home. The wafers have been touched only by Mary-Ellen Yaroshefski (wearing gloves); only she and Mother Judith will have touched the bags themselves. There are 2 ways to arrange to have these wafers.

1. At church: Sunday 10am and 3 pm; Monday 10am-2pm & 5:30-6:30 pm; Tuesday & Wednesday, 10am-2pm (contact the office) Thursday (Christmas Eve 3-3:30 pm)

2. Mother Judith will deliver them to your home, leaving them on your front porch. Please contact Mother Judith by phone (716.949.8194) or email (jlee.trinitychurchmilford@gmail.com).
