

Lenten Book Study: Sundays 4-5 pm February 21st – March 21st on Zoom



Ladder to the Light by Steven Charleston.

Steven Charleston is an Episcopal priest, former Episcopal Bishop of Alaska, and a Chocktaw elder. *Ladder to the Light* draws upon the traditional Christian and indigenous teachings to offer insights into seeking hope and courage "in the valley of the shadows." We will discuss 2 chapters each week (about 25-30 pages).

Weekly Bible Study: Fridays @ Noon on Zoom: February 19 – March 26: The Psalms

Based upon reading a Psalm each day, we will discuss the theological, spiritual, and emotional range of this profoundly beautiful anthology of prayers.

Lentopoly is a game that is meant to incorporate the 3 aspects of Lent: prayer, fasting & almsgiving. Based on the model of Monopoly, each square describes an act of fasting, prayer, or giving to be done by the players. By doing the charitable acts each day the child "earns" tokens (nails, pennies, beans, etc.). You can have a container full of tokens and each child has their own jar to put their 'earned' tokens into each day. Game materials will be available and delivered to families by Ash Wednesday.
