The Vestry met on June 22nd and made the following decisions for July and August:

1.We will continue with Morning Prayer via ZOOM, and we will plan one special outdoor service in

August, pending public health protocols and peer review by the Dean and the Bishop. Beginning on July 15, pending peer review by the Dean and Bishop, the church will be open for private prayer for an hour on Tuesday mornings, Thursday evenings and Sunday mornings

- 2, At the July 13th meeting the Vestry will decide when to open the building to community groups and under what conditions.
- 3. The Vestry will decide whether to open the building for small groups of parish members.
- 4. For the month of July the office will be open on appointment only on Mondays and Thursdays, 10am 3pm

<u>July 13th</u> – The Vestry will appoint the members of the Profile and Search Committees

<u>July 19th</u> – During Sunday Morning Prayer Mother Judith will commission these members and they will be Readers in the service.

<u>July 20th – August 17th – The Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT), also known as the Holy Cow Survey will be available to be completed online.</u>

<u>August 10th</u> Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search and Profile Committees to introduce the logistics of the search and to do a Mutual Ministry Review.

<u>September 12th</u> Canon Simpson will meet with the Vestry, Search, and profile Committees to review the results of the CAT and to advise on beginning work on the Profile.

Meanwhile, we will be clearing out the storage areas in the church building and the choir room.
