The Vestry met on June 22nd and made the following decisions for July and August:

- 1.We will continue with Morning Prayer via ZOOM, and we will plan one special outdoor service in August, pending public health protocols. Beginning on July 15, the church will be open for private prayer on Thursday evenings and Sunday mornings
- 2, At the July 13th meeting the Vestry will decide when to open the building to community groups and under what conditions.
- 3. The Vestry will decide after the current schedule of ZOOM parish meetings whether to open the building for small groups of parish members.
- 4. The office will be open on appointment only on Mondays and Thursdays, 10am 3pm
