Stewardship Reflection by Kevin Keppler

Among the many blessings we have at Trinity is leadership. From our Interim to our Vestry to the leadership of the various ministries, we are a very well led Christian community.

Today's example is the financial conscience of Trinity, our Treasurer Cheryl Eidinger-Taylor. Cheryl has poured all the complexities of our transition into a spreadsheet and produced a number. The number includes the budget increase from an Interim to a Rector next summer. It is based on other assumptions which we won't go into here. The number is 16.5%. Our budget for 2021 must increase by 16.5% over this year.

What do we do with this? Cheryl has given us much, but our job is to take this farther.

First, we have to consider the people whose finances have been turned inside out by the pandemic. This reduces the number of those who can respond by increasing their pledge to meet our needs in 2021. For those of us who are unaffected by Covid, or whose business has increased, this means that we are called to increase our pledges by more than 16.5% in order to fill the gap left by those whose industries are shut down by the pandemic.
