Worship at Trinity: October & November 2020

Beginning on October 4th you have three different alternatives to receiving Holy Communion every Sunday at Trinity without losing the sense of community that we have found in our service of Morning Prayer on Zoom and without the risks associated with indoor gathering.

- 1. **8 am Informal In Person service of Holy Communion in the parking lot** no music, no liturgical ministers, no hymnals or prayer brooks; masks and hand sanitizer required and available; parking on the street or the adjacent parking log.
 - Capacity: 30 persons.
- 2. **10:30am-11:30am** Individual communion on the sanctuary with private prayer. Mother Judith will distribute from the altar; masks & sanitizer will be required and available; separate entrance and exits will be monitored.
- 3. **Sunday afternoon** Mother Judith will bring Communion to your home as requested for a brief service of private communion, outside if possible.

Signup – To begin, we will not require prior registration for the service. We expect to have adequate space for everyone who wishes to participate. A team will call members who currently receive weekly mailings to ask 3 questions about the Sundays in October:

- a. If you will attend the outdoor service
- b. If you would like to receive communion separately at the church
- c. If you would like communion brought to you at home

The service will be 20-30 minutes, so that participants will have time to return home and join Morning Prayer at 9 am or Zoom conversation at 9:35.
