Skit - The Road to Emmaus Luke 24:13-32

Narrator: On Easter Sunday, right after some women discovered that Jesus was no longer in his tomb, two followers of Jesus were walking to a village called Emmaus, which was about 7 miles from Jerusalem.

Cleopas: I'm very sad.

Follower 2: Yeah, it's very sad that Jesus died.

Narrator: The Jesus appeared near them, but they did not recognize him.

Jesus: Hi guys, what are you talking about?

Cleopas: Are you the only one visiting Jerusalem who doesn't know what's going on?

Jesus: What's going on?

Follower 2: There was a guy called Jesus, who was a powerful prophet.

Cleopas: The chief priests and our rulers had him put to death.

Follower 2: They crucified him.

Cleopas: Yeah, we hoped that he would have been the one to save Israel.

Follower 2: But this morning, we heard from some women that Jesus was no longer in his tomb!

Jesus: Wow, you guys are slow to believe in what the prophets have said! Don't you realize that the savior would have to suffer and then enter into his glory?

Narrator: Then Jesus explained to them everything in the Scriptures about himself, starting with Moses and the other prophets.

Cleopas: You know the scriptures really well! So Jesus must have been our savior.

Follower 2: It's almost evening. Hey, do you want to stay with us for dinner at this village?

Jesus: Sure!

Narrator: When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them.

Follower 2: Wait a minute, isn't this...

Cleopas: Isn't this JESUS?

Narrator: Once they recognized Jesus, he disappeared from their sight.

Cleopas: Weren't our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures?

Follower 2: Yeah, I can't believe we didn't recognize him earlier.

Cleopas: I guess we weren't sure if he was alive or dead.

Narrator: Then the two followers of Jesus went and told the 11 apostles what had happened.
